'Valley of the Lakes Run' to Brisbane Valley
Sunday 7th June 2009
Fernvale, Wivenhoe, Somerset, Kilcoy, Mt Mee,
Dayboro, Samford

Pick up at Goodna at the second petrol station on the service road.

To Morning..Tea (Fernvale)

Boundary Rd Thornlands, Mackenzie, Gateway M'way, Logan M'way (2 tolls).
Pick up at Goodna at the second petrol station on the service road. If you miss the turnoff at the roadworks, catch you at BP Blacksoil or Fernvale. Take the Toowoomba turnoff left off Ipswich M'way (on to Warrego Highway). After BP Blacksoil use right lane to turn RIGHT towards Esk.

Turn RIGHT in Fernvale after bakery and pull up on the grassed area under the trees on the left, behind the pub.

Morning Tea

To Lunch

Extreme care turning RIGHT back on to highway. Depending on traffic density, you might choose to turn left and U turn a few 100m down the road). Lake levels are high. Stop for any good views of Lake Wivenhoe.

Carry on to Esk where we can pause for a look around on foot.

4km out of Esk, RIGHT onto Esk-Kilcoy Rd.

12 to 14 km Caboonbah Homestead was burnt out a few weeks ago.

Carry on towards Lake Somerset.

Stop for any good views of the lake.

Not sure of the ideal lunch stop spot. Please discuss beforehand.

Lunch

To Samford

To Kilcoy and on to Woodford.

4km from Woodford, RIGHT at D'Aguilar (to Mt Mee & Dayboro).

You will soon have an approx 5km climb.

10km from D'Aguilar stop at Darwongah Lookout on the left for coastal views.

Continue through Mt Mee and on to Dayboro.

At Dayboro, RIGHT at T junction, then after 200/300m LEFT at T junction.

Onwards through Closeburn and to Samford Village

To Home

Continue on, LEFT at roundabout.

Samford Rd will now lead you through Ferny Grove, Enoggera, and on to Kelvin Grove, Countess St, Cook Bridge, and home.
