Don't forget your Rocker Cover Racer

The rules are so simple it's easy

1. All vehicles to be powered by gravity, this is an environmentally friendly event and no creatures are to be harmed during the running of the races.
2. Your rocker cover must be of the same motoring heritage as your car, e.g. if you have a Chevrolet you can use a Holden one and if you own a Morris then any BMC/Leyland vehicle can be used
3. Maximum size is 750 mm long by 250 mm wide and no higher than 300 mm including driver.
4. Maximum weight 5 kg excluding driver.
5. Wings, body kits and spoilers are allowed as long as they are within the size rules, as above.
6. Advertising is allowed and encourage, make your racer look fantastic for the photos.
7. Drivers do not need crash helmets or even seat belts, but a bit of glue may help.
