Eastern Darling Downs & Oakey

General Idea:

Leave Cleveland S/G 7.30am Sat morning, quick morning tea at Gatton (117km), then to Clifton (+69km) & visit Historical Museum if possible, Nobby (markets?), Felton, Felton East, Pittsworth (+45km), Southbrook, Westbrook, Toowoomba (+38km) & visit MRD Heritage Centre, Oakey (+30km), RSL for dinner, Oakey overnight. Sunday to Goombungee, Kingsthorpe, Queens Park for Toowoomba Languages & Cultural Festival and lunch, then proceed down range by 1.00pm. Home by 3.00pm.

Arrangements:

To register your attendance, please call David on 0411.694072 preferably by Fri 16th July. Motel in Oakey to be decided by popular vote \$88, \$101, or \$108. Dinner at RSL (walking distance), numbers required please.

To Morning Tea at Apex Park Gatton

Passing through Thornlands, Sheldon, Burbank, Mackenzie, Logan & Ipswich Mwys, Warrego Hwy, Gatton turnoff, Gatton, Apex Park.

1. Boundary Rd Thornlands, MtCotton Rd Burbank, P/up Caltex Mackenzie.
2. 2nd traffic lights LEFT, RIGHT Miles Platting Rd, 2nd LEFT Gateway Mwy, IMMEDIATELY RIGHT to Ipswich & Toowoomba (A2). 2 tolls.
3. Take Ipswich bypass towards Toowoomba onto Warrego Hwy (A2).
4. P/up members at BP Blacksoil, then on past Marburg, Plainland etc.
5. Gatton exit at Lawes. LEFT 2nd lights in Gatton. Over the hill to Apex Park.

M/Tea 9.15am

To Lunch at Nobby

Left at Grantham, Ma Ma Creek Rd, then on to Clifton and Nobby.

6. 9.40am. Continue west approx 6 km from Apex Park to Grantham then LEFT towards Clifton and Warwick. Now 53 km to New England Highway.
7. Care with a few of the corners, but it is generally a good drive.
8. LEFT onto New England Highway (A3) and, after 1 km, RIGHT to Clifton.
9. Now 8km to Clifton. 10.45am. Visit Clifton Historical Museum if open.
10. 11.45am. 8km north to Nobby. If we missed Clifton Historical Museum, we will catch the last hour of Nobby Markets.
11. Stop for lunch at Nobby.

To Main Roads Heritage Centre, Toowoomba

12. 12.45pm. 38km west to Pittsworth.
13. 1.25pm through Pittsworth. Then via Southbrook, Westbrook and Drayton, into Toowoomba (40km) via Gore Hwy.
14. With Drayton & Tba cemetery on your left, turn LEFT into South St.
15. RIGHT Greenwattle St, *all the way to the dead end*, then LEFT Mutze St.

16. 2.20pm. Main Roads Heritage Centre, around the next corner on the left halfway down Mutze St Toowoomba.

To Overnight Stop at Oakey

17. 3.20pm. 30km west to Oakey along Warrego Hwy.
18. 4.00pm Check into motel. 4.30pm Cheese and bikkies on the deck.
19. 6.00pm dinner at Oakey RSL.
20. Overnight Oakey.

Sunday Morning

21. 7am to noon. Oakey Rotary Markets, Railway carpark, Bridge St. Free.
22. 10.00am. 17km north, then RIGHT, 12 km to Goombungee, RIGHT, then 20km to Kingsthorpe.
23. LEFT at Kingsthorpe into North St, becomes Glencoe Rd.
24. After 3 to 4 km, slow down and RIGHT at Toowoomba sign.
25. At T junction, RIGHT to Gowrie Junction (in my notes but can't recall it).
26. At Gowrie Junction T junction, turn LEFT. About 60km from Oakey.
27. 11.30am. Head towards Queens Park to visit Toowoomba Languages & Cultures Festival 10am – 4pm.
28. *Lunch*
29. At your convenience, head down range and home via route of choice.
